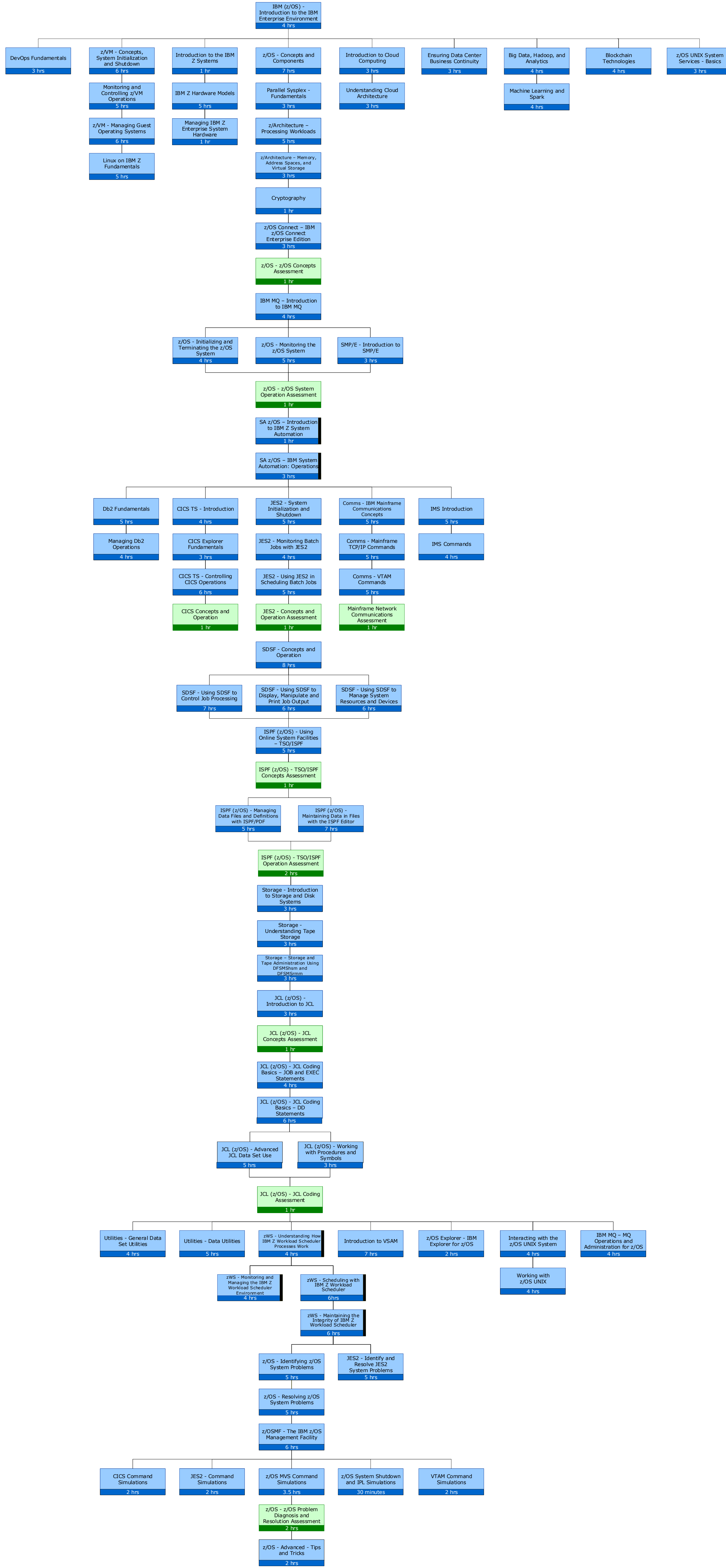


The computer operator provides first-level support for any problems associated with system, batch, or online activity. The duties of this position are:

- Powering the computer system up and down
- Monitoring the system console for any error messages and responding to simple requests
- Monitoring the processing of batch jobs and resolving simple JCL or job processing problems
- Identifying and resolving general network problems
- Responding to tape or cartridge requests and performing recovery action if required
